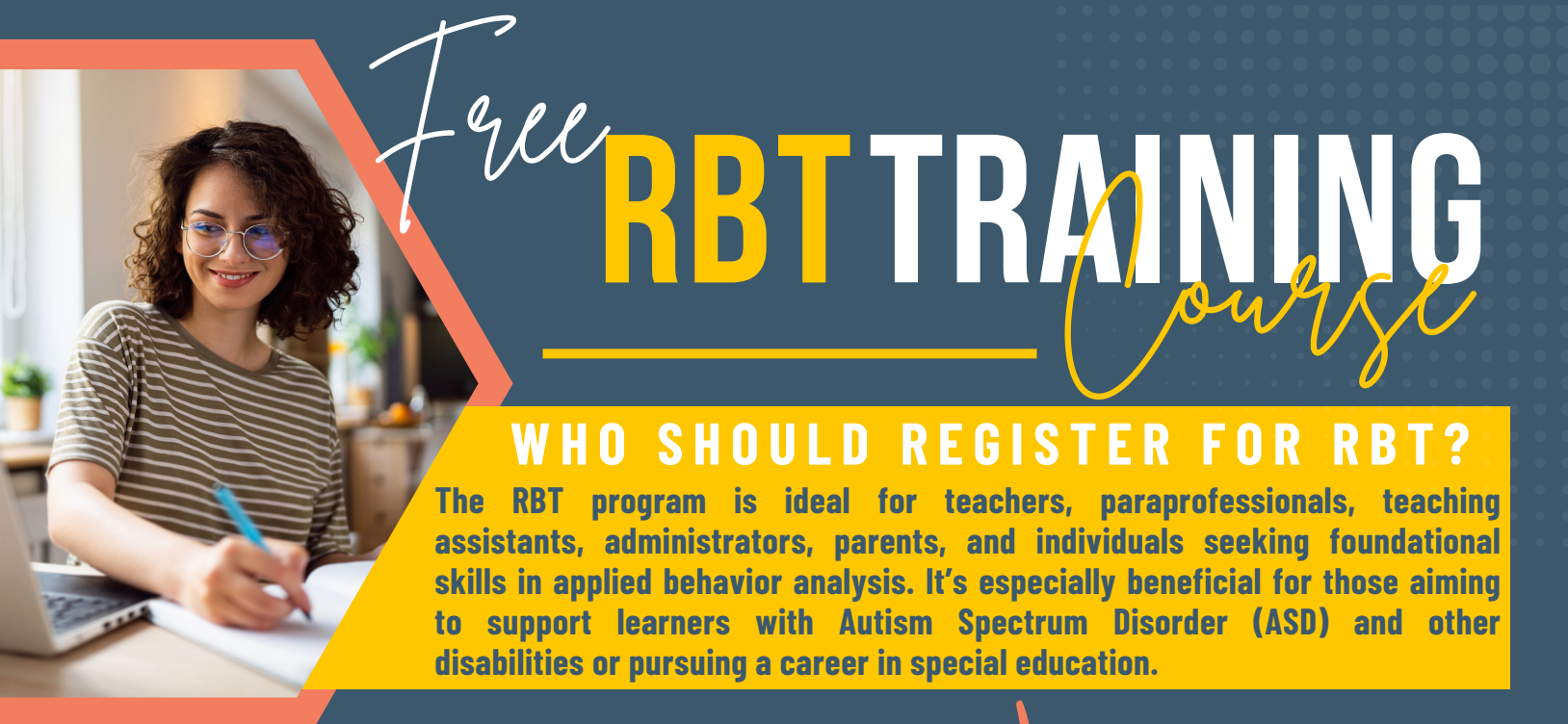




Free RBT TRAINING Course

WHO SHOULD REGISTER FOR RBT?

The RBT program is ideal for teachers, paraprofessionals, teaching assistants, administrators, parents, and individuals seeking foundational skills in applied behavior analysis. It's especially beneficial for those aiming to support learners with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and other disabilities or pursuing a career in special education.

REQUIREMENTS:

What is a REGISTERED BEHAVIOR TECHNICIAN?

The Behavior Analysis Certification Board (BACB) defines an RBT as a certified paraprofessional in behavior analysis who provides behavior-analytic services under the supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) or Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA).

ABOUT THIS COURSE:

This free course offers a thorough introduction to Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), presenting an overview of the field and its structure. It covers critical topics such as Behavior Reduction strategies, Assessments, and Skill Acquisition, along with essential practices for Data Collection, Graphing, and accurate Documentation and Reporting. Additionally, it emphasizes Professional Conduct, Scope of Practice, and Ethics, providing a solid foundation for professional work in ABA.

Participants can expect 40 hours of online training, featuring school-based examples and built-in checks for understanding. Each module includes relevant resources and handouts, and learners will have access to Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs) for questions and support. Upon completion, a Certificate of Completion will be awarded. The course is self-paced, free of charge, and allows 180 days to start and complete the content, with a minimum requirement of 5 days for completion. It is suitable for individuals seeking knowledge in ABA, regardless of their intent to obtain credentialing.

THIS TRAINING PROGRAM IS BASED ON THE RBT TASK LIST (2ND ED.) AND IS DESIGNED TO MEET THE 40-HOUR TRAINING REQUIREMENT FOR RBT CERTIFICATION. THE PROGRAM IS OFFERED INDEPENDENT OF THE BACB.
